Grants from the Supporting Science Fund support natural science-oriented programs for non-profit organizations located in Humboldt, Del Norte, Trinity and Mendocino Counties. The Supporting Science Fund is a donor advised fund provided by the Humboldt Area Foundation + Wild Rivers Community Foundation. Funds can support 501c3 non-profits, public benefit organizations (tribal governments, government units, hospitals, school, and churches) or qualified fiscal sponsor. If you have a natural science-oriented project you need funded that you feel fits the goals and objective of this fund, then please fill out the application below as instructed. Once approved by the donor, applications will be recommended and monies will be received within 2-3 weeks. Areas that this fund support include biology (ecology, marine biology, evolution, botany, biodiversity, restoration, wild animal rehabilitation, field studies, etc.), wildlife, geology, astronomy, paleontology, and chemistry. This fund can be used to support classrooms, scientific supplies, research, conferences, professional development, stipends, and field and lab equipment among other things.
