Trinity County temperatures can dip as low as 23° in the winter then into the 100° in the summer while coastal Humboldt may hover around 55° in the winter and an average of 64° in the summer!


Pack accordingly: Layers and sensible shoes are your friends.

California Redwood Coast -Humboldt County Airport (ACV)

ACV is located directly off of Highway 101 just north of Arcata. It is a small airport serviced by United and AVELO Airlines. Morning and evening flights are sometimes delayed or canceled due to fog, so plan accordingly.

San Francisco International Airport (SFO)


SFO is located approximately 273 miles south of Eureka, near the junction of Highways 101 and 380. It takes approximately 6 hours to drive here from SFO.

Humboldt County: Getting around

CAR RENTALS – <u>Enterprise Rent-A-Car</u> has a location at ACV. We recommend making reservations in advance. Please call their office at (707) 839-4937 for the most up to date hours.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION – Humboldt Transportation Authority (hta.org) has the most up-to-date information. Many areas in Humboldt County, including the HAF Campus in Bayside, are only accessible by car.

RIDESHARES AND TAXIS – Uber and Lyft are not as widely available here as they may be in bigger cities. We have three local cab companies: City Cab (707) 442-4551, Supreme Rides (707) 496-6669 and Cab Louie (707) 599-3391.



Del Norte County Regional Airport

The Del Norte County Regional Airport (CEC) offers daily direct flights to and from Oakland, California (OAK) by Contour Airlines.

San Francisco International Airport (SFO)

SFO is located approximately 355 miles south of Crescent City, near the junction of Highways 101 and 380. It takes roughly 7 hours to drive here from SFO.

Del Norte County: Getting around

CAR RENTALS – There are two car rental agencies located at the airport. We recommend making reservations in advance and checking their open hours. Avis Car Rental (707) 465-6666 Hertz Car Rental (707) 464-5750.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION – Regional bus service is provided throughout Del Norte County by <u>Redwood Coast Transit</u>, which services Crescent City, Smith River, Gasquet and more.

RIDESHARES AND TAXIS – Uber and Lyft are not as widely available here as they may be in bigger cities. Cell reception is also not reliable in some parts of the county. Coastal Cab Company services Crescent City: (707) 458-5708.



Del Norte County Regional Airport

The nearest regional airport to Brookings is in Crescent City, California (about 30 minutes south). Contour Air offers two trips in and out of Crescent City to Oakland each day. There are two car rental agencies located at the airport. Avis Car Rental (707) 465-6666 Hertz Car Rental (707) 464-5750

Rogue Valley International - Medford Airport

Redding Regional Airport

The nearest regional airport to Weaverville is about one hour and connects to San Francisco, Los Angeles, Seattle and Las Vegas. There are three car rental agencies located at the airport. <u>Avis</u> (530) 221-2855, <u>Budget</u> (530) 722-9122 and <u>Hertz</u> (530) 221-4620

Weaverville is a 3.5 hour drive from Sacramento and 4 hours from the San Francisco East Bay, 3 hours from Medford, and 2 hours from Eureka. Road conditions on US Hwy 299 can be variable. Check <u>https://roads.dot.ca.gov/</u> before traveling.


