PAUL HARRIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Paul P. Harris, the Founder of Rotary, was born in Racine Wisconsin on April 19, 1868. After graduating from the Law School of Iowa in 1891, he spent five years touring the world and learning to understand his fellow men. He returned to begin his law practice in Chicago in 1896. Through his practice he came to believe that business people and professionals could join in an atmosphere of friendship and fellowship to improve the quality of life in their local and world wide communities.

A small group who shared this vision met for the first time on February 23, 1905 in Chicago, IL. The group adopted the name Rotary because its members met, in rotation, in their various places of business. Paul Harris was instrumental in extending Rotary to other cities and by 1910 there were 16 clubs throughout the nation. The philosophy of the organization quickly spread beyond the United States. Paul Harris became president of the International Association of Rotary clubs when it was initially formed in 1912. The legacy continues. There are now about 33,000 Rotary clubs in over 150 countries throughout the world.

Fortuna Sunrise Rotary was chartered with forty members on February 23, 1995, the 90th anniversary of the founding of Rotary. In recognition of February 23rd being Rotary International's World Understanding and Peace Day and to promote the memory of Paul Harris, Fortuna Sunrise Rotary has launched a community project. We have established the Paul Harris Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Fortuna Sunrise Rotary is pleased to offer two \$1,750 scholarships in memory of Rotary founder, Paul Harris. Fortuna High School graduating seniors who share Paul Harris's vision of world harmony through understanding of and service to one's local and global community are encouraged to apply.

Applicants should be aware that these scholarships are not affiliated with those offered by Fortuna Rotary. In general, the two organizations have agreed to make efforts to recognize as many different and deserving students as possible. If a student applies for awards offered by both clubs and becomes a finalist for both clubs, members of the respective scholarship committees will determine which club's award will be given.

 - 2. Your S.A.T. scores, if taken (Not required)
- C. Enclose information on an additional sheet if more space is needed to answer questions on the application.
- D. Three letters of recommendation are required. These letters should be from teachers, employers, or other people who know you well. These letters must be received by the committee no later than May 2nd 2025 either directly from the recommending person or as part of your application packet.
- E. The application must be received by the committee by May 2nd, 2025.
